



HADRIAN'S WALL—SPONSORED WALK  
in support of Money for Madagascar  
TO CELEBRATE THERESA'S 80<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY



Hilary Bradt and Theresa Haine will be walking the length of Hadrian's Wall (84 miles) at the end of June/early July. Why not join them for parts of, or the entire journey. Alternatively, you may just want to sponsor them in aid of Money for Madagascar.

We would love to have some more octogenarians on all or part of the walk as it will be brilliant for publicity! Vindolanda, a mile south from Once Brewed is a wonderful place to visit so how about an "octogenarian weekend" on 29<sup>th</sup>/30<sup>th</sup> June? Of course, adults and children of any age will be more than welcome.



The best patch, as far as seeing the wall and museums etc. is between Chollerford and Birdoswald which is just past Gilsland. If you want to stay or camp overnight it is strongly recommended to book early. The book "Hadrian's Wall Path" published by Trailblazer is invaluable for information on where to stay and what to see.

## Itinerary and Plan of the walk, and where they will be staying:

**26th June** - Osborne Hotel in Jesmond (Newcastle).

It is a 10-minute walk to the metro, which will take us to Wallsend and the start of the walk. 11.5 miles to walk to Newburn.

**27th June** – Keelman’s Lodge, Newburn.

10.5 miles to walk to East Wallhouses.



**28th June** – Matfen High House B&B, East Wallhouses.

9.5 miles to walk to Chollerford.

**29th June** – The Dovecote B&B, Chollerford (1/2 mile north of the trail).

12 miles to walk to Once Brewed.

**30th June** – Vallum Lodge Once Brewed.

8 miles to walk to Gilsland.

**1st July** - Hill on the Wall, Gilsland.

A “fortified 16th century house”. 11 miles to walk to Newtown.

**2nd July** – Orchard House B&B, Newtown.

10 miles walk to Carlisle.

**3rd July** – Langleigh Guest House, Carlisle.

Dylan and his wife Elaine (friends from Wales) will join us here. They are short of time and obviously experienced walkers because they plan to do much longer walks between stops and will catch us up in Carlisle. 9 miles to walk to Boustead Hill.



**4th July** – Hillstead Farm, Boustead Hill.

9 miles to walk to Bowness on Solway.

**5th July** – The Kings Arms, Bowness.

(Bus to Carlisle stops right outside the door.)

**6th July** – travel home.
