MfM supports communities in Madagascar to preserve rainforests and protect biodiversity

Unique Madagascar.....

- Madagascar is 'megadiverse', with 5% of all known animal and plant species on the planet found there
- 250,000 species, including over 100 lemur species, are found nowhere else on earth!
- New species are still being identified all the time, many plants have useful properties that can be used to treat serious conditions such as cancer and diabetes



Fragile Madagascar....

- Poverty is threatening the future of both the people and the wildlife of Madagascar
- Madagascar is one of the poorest countries in the world with 50% of children suffering malnutrition
- Over 80% of virgin forest has been lost
- Of Madagascar's 101 lemur species, 22 are critically endangered & 48 are endangered



What is MfM doing?

- MfM provides impoverished farmers with sustainable alternatives to deforestation so that they no longer need to destroy the precious forest for survival
- MfM supports community-led restoration of the endangered Indri lemur's rainforest habitat; planting rainforest corridors with over 60 species on indigenous trees
- MfM supports locally led ecotourism initiatives, enabling Malagasy people to benefit from local biodiversity
- MfM supports environmental education, bringing up a new generation to understand the value of their unique natural heritage
