AAA: Rehabilitation of the Arthémésia House (toilets, roofing, painting, safety features, and decoration): QUAPEM 2.

AAB: Inauguration of a new dormitory (26% of total funding provided by **MfM**).

AAF: Repair of the water pump, rehabilitation library, voluntary house.

AH: Repainting of interior walls and installation of new durable flooring.

AG: Acquisition of new equipment (furniture, sanitary kits, bins, books, etc.),

Staff Capacity Building:

Business plan development, creativity and child-friendly communication, as well as awareness-raising on child trauma to strengthen psychosocial support, daily task management and the use of working tools.

Development of Income-Generating Activities (IGAs):

AAA: Establishment of a pig farming project (5 pigs) funded by PADEM,
Promote training and empowerment of young girls through pig farming and organic waste recycling
Restaurant & snack bar, Training in eco-charcoal and paper recycling, rental services (hall, pagoda, vehicle).
Egg production and sales, an arts and crafts shop, volunteer accommodation.

AAB: No IGA yet in operation (new management in place). Planned IGA: Volunteer accommodation

AAF: Catering, rabbit farming, and handicraft sales, volunteer accommodation



Number of Beneficiaries per Centre - Fiscal Year 2024–2025








Meals provided this year
